

Be an Angel...

Africa A+ Schools (A+) is in need of angel donors. Would you like to become one?

A+ is a registered Non-profit Organization (NPO Registration No. 220-868) working in the Early Childhood Education (ECE) space and specializing in Foundation Phase (ages 0-10, Preschool/nursery school to Grade 3). **A+** was founded in 2014 and is currently active in Western, Eastern and Northern Cape provinces of South Africa where it trains Foundation Phase teachers. The organization enjoys the oversight of a Board which meets quarterly.

You may wonder whether **A+** is just one of many teacher-training NPOs. Well, not actually. Our approach and methods differ from the norm. The norm is to provide NQF (National Qualifying Framework) courses and certificates. These qualifications, while useful in improving the employability of their holders, do not do much to improve the actual quality of teaching in the classroom. (We know this from experience.)

A+ addresses the gaps between NQF training and classroom implementation (and the needs of teachers with no qualifications at all), by placing emphasis squarely on five vitally

important aspects of teaching and learning:

(1) practical techniques for quality ECE in the classroom,

(2) enrichment through the creative arts (the "A plus" in our name – see photo),

(3) sustainable improvement through extended programmes (regular workshops over at least three years) and the training of local Community Facilitators/mentors,

(4) addressing the needs of each



school individually without attempting to apply a one-size-fits-all approach, and (5) involving all community stakeholders, including parents, in our programmes.

A+ has eight regular employees: four Facilitators, who do the actual teacher training, and four support staff (from left to right below): Dr Giulietta Harrison (Executive Director), James Harrison (Fundraiser), Shayne Eastman (Bookkeeper), Arthur Knox (Web Manager). While Facilitators' salaries are paid from project funds, unfortunately support/admin staff

are usually explicitly excluded from corporate-funding budgets. This creates a dilemma for NPOs because they are not able to run effectively without their support staff. This funding gap needs to be filled by "angel" donations. Our needs are laid out in detail in the table below. Donors can select any of the specified amounts, or any combination thereof, or donate any other amount of their own choosing.
